Our working definition of coalition is: "an ongoing multidisciplinary state- (or tribal-) level collaborative with defined membership that is dedicated to identifying and addressing gaps or inadequacies in policy and practice related to elder abuse detection, prevention, and intervention." They may also be called networks, councils, commissions, associations, partnerships, and task forces.
